CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT SIDNEY D. COLLIATIE

Chief Master Sergeant Sidney D. Colliatie is the Command Chief, 184th Intelligence Wing, Kansas Air National Guard, McConnell Air Force Base, Kansas. The 1,300-plus members of the 184th operate a diverse set of missions focusing on intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance operations, network and information operations, full-spectrum command and control and Smokey Hill Weapons Range. The Wing also fields a full compliment of support functions including civil engineering, security forces, medical, and force support units. The 184th Intelligence Wing operates as a key node in the Air Force Distributed Common Ground System, providing deployed combat forces near-real time processing, exploitation, and dissemination of reconnaissance aircraft sensor data. Additionally, the wing is responsible for the operation and security of the entire Air National Guard network cyber domain. Chief Colliatie advises the wing commander on the health, morale, welfare, mission effectiveness and proper utilization of the more-than 1,300 personnel assigned to five groups comprised of 14 squadrons, two of which are geographically separated.



Chief Colliatie enlisted in the Kansas Air National Guard in August 1984 with the 184th Tactical Fighter Group where he served twenty years as an Air Frame Repair Technician on the F-4D Phantom, the F-16 A&B, C&D Fighting Falcon, B-1B Lancer and the KC-135R Strato-Tanker until 2004 when he was selected as the Structural Maintenance Shop Supervisor managing 17 full time and traditional guardsmen. In 2009 he was selected as the 184th Intelligence Support Squadron's Communications Operations Chief responsible for the 75 airmen and 30 contractors who maintained the communication infrastructure necessary to conduct 24/7 MQ-1 Predator, MQ-9 Reaper and U-2 Dragon Lady intelligence gathering missions in support of Operations IRAQI FREEDOM, ENDURING FREEDOM and NEW DAWN. In 2010 Chief Colliatie was assigned to the National Guard Bureau coordinating manpower, Unit Manning Documents, Unit Type Codes, Designed Operational Capability Statements with mission allocation in support of five Active Duty and eight Air National Guard Distributed Common Ground System Units. In 2011 he was selected as the 184th Intelligence Support Squadron Superintendent responsible for the Chief Enlisted Manager duties. January 2015, Chief Colliatie was selected as the 134th Air Control Squadron Maintenance Superintendent and also filled the role of Chief Enlisted Advisor to the Squadron Commander. He advised the Commander on all squadron issues related to the enlisted force, oversight of operational events, exercises, training, professional development, resources, personnel assessments and programs and was responsible for the 185 airmen who maintain the Ground Theater Air Control Weapon Systems. November 2015, Chief Colliatie volunteered to deploy to an undisclosed location in Southwest Asia in support of Operations ENDURING FREEDOM and INHERENT RESOLVE as the 727 Expeditionary Air Control Squadron Maintenance Superintendent responsible for over 200 Airmen assigned to nine Detachments.
