### **COLONEL JASON L. KNOBBE**

Colonel Jason L. Knobbe is the Vice Wing Commander, 184th Intelligence Wing, Kansas Air National Guard, McConnell Air Force Base, Kansas. He assists the commander in leading, managing, and developing over 1,300 Guardsmen who execute a broad spectrum of missions including intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance; cyberspace operations; and command and control, all of which greatly enhance the U.S. Air Force's capability to provide actionable intelligence and cyberspace operations for combat forces around the globe.

Colonel Knobbe is a 1994 graduate of the University of Kansas. He went on to earn a Master's of Science, Education and a Reserve Officer Training Corps commission from the University of Kansas in 1998. Prior to his current assignment, he served as the Commander of the 184th Missions Support Group, the Commander of the 177th Information Aggressor Squadron, a National Security Agency Certified Cyber and Information Operations Red Team. He also served as the Deputy Group Commander for the 184th Regional Support Group, at the time, the second largest group in the Air National Guard. Colonel Knobbe is a Cyberspace Operations Officer, Aircraft Commander, and a Weapons Systems Operator whose assignments span all three career fields. Throughout his career, Colonel Knobbe has supported several deployments in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom.
